

1 Penrose, Rashleigh Lane, PL23 IHP

Large mixed garden with flower and shrub borders and a sunken picnic area.

Part of the garden is left wild and there is a seating area.

Access: At the top round-about turn down Lankelly Lane, after 50 yards turn left down Rashleigh Lane and Penrose is 50 yards on the right.

10am – 4pm

2 The Plantation Gardens, PL23 IBQ

A delightful but lost public garden brought back by volunteers from a jungle of brambles, nettles and years of neglect.

Access: Two entrances: Lostwithiel Street with steps and Hanson Drive, no steps.

24 hours but daylight recommended for safety

3 Grammar School Garden, 47 Esplanade, PL23 IHZ

This lovely harbour side shingle garden offers swathes of tall grasses and seaside planting.

Access: through a gate and down steps to two levels. Dogs on leads please.

10am – 5pm

4 The Old Library, PL23 IBU

A lovely walled garden with herbs and exotics - a secluded sun trap.

Access: Side gates on Browns Hill and Cobbs Well. All on one level if approached via the Cobbs Well gate.

10am – 4pm

5 I Church Avenue, PL23 IBU

A pretty and secluded garden overlooking Fowey church and Place.

Access: Through side gate and up stone steps.

10am – 5pm

6 Broadstairs, 37 North Street, PL23 IDB

Spectacular river views with tropical plants, an English garden & fruit trees.

Come and enjoy tea & cake at the top. Sorry no dogs.

Access: Blue side gate between #29 & #31 North Street, steps leading to 4 levels but well worth the effort!
